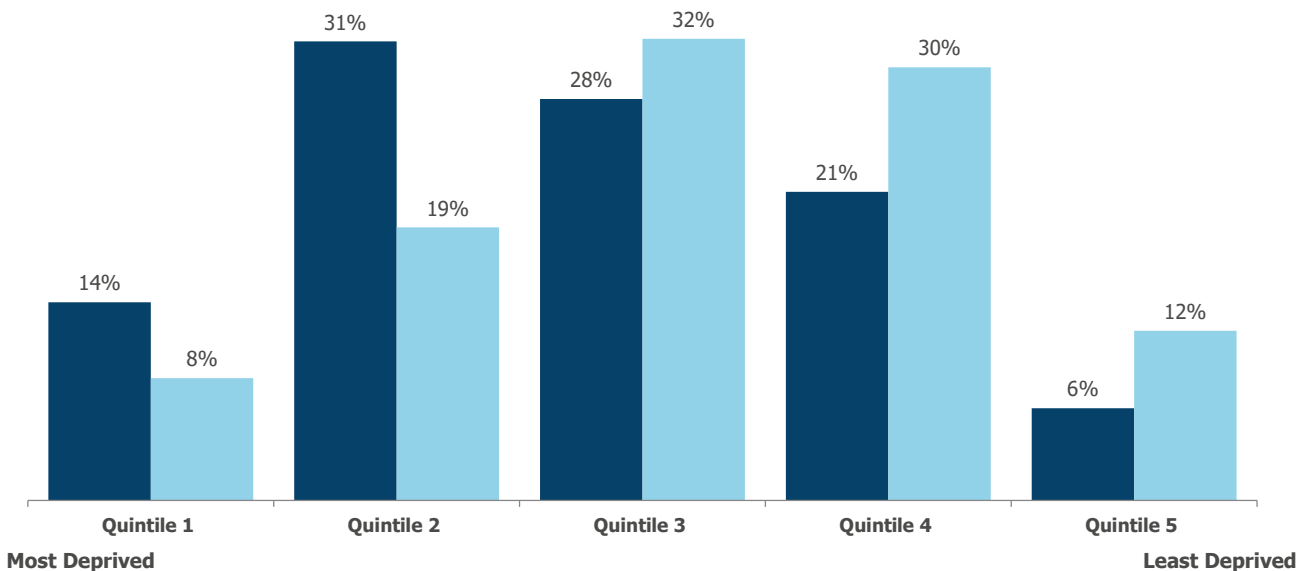

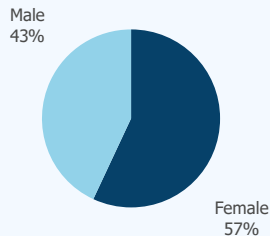

% of datazones in Local Authority that are in each Scottish quintile

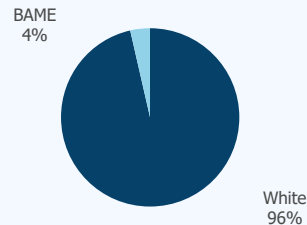

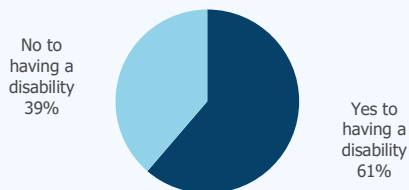

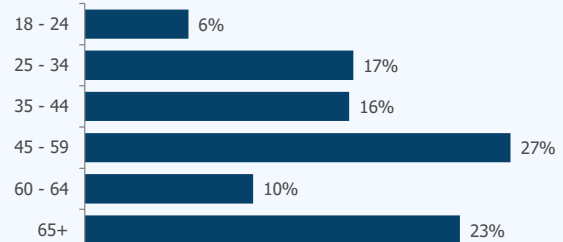

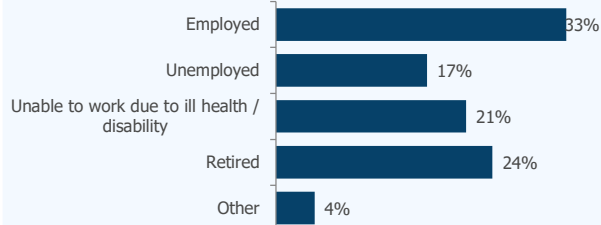

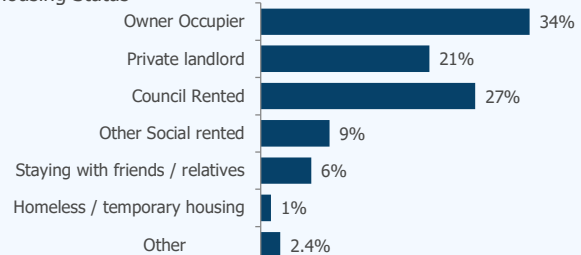
