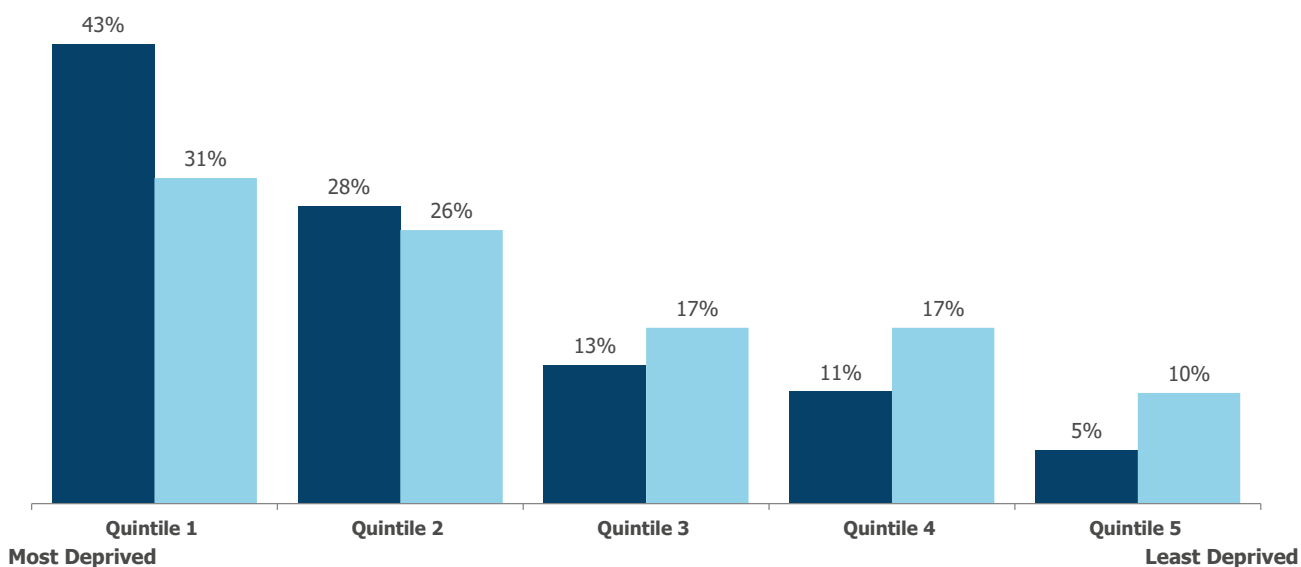

### Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation - clients and population residing within Local Authority



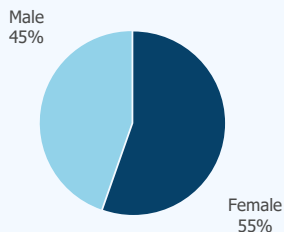

% of datazones in Local Authority that are in each Scottish quintile

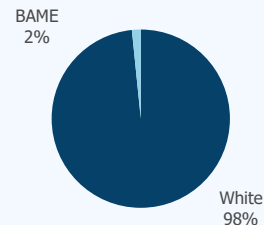

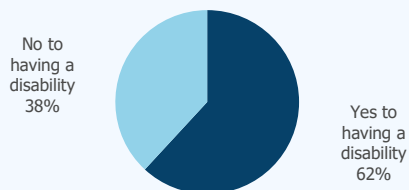

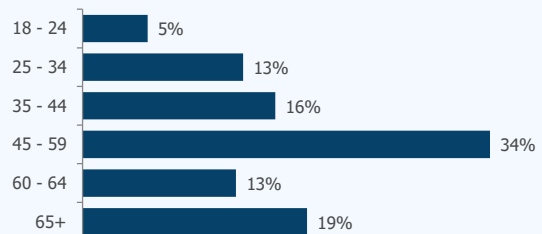

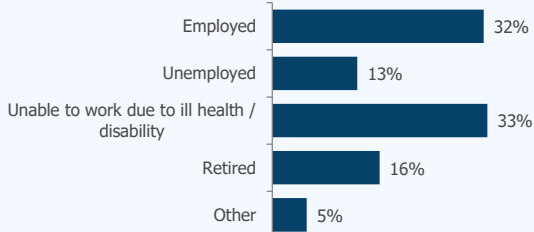

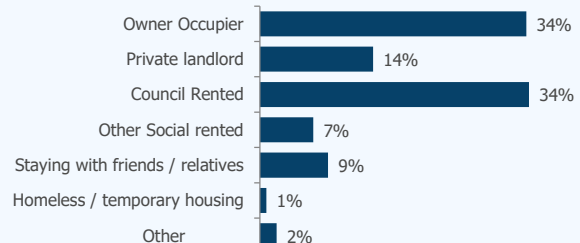
